The Union Tourism Secretary is the chairperson of the Board of Governors (BoG) of IHM Pusa who is holding all the administrative and financial powers of the

		institute. The Principal of the institute is authorized to sign sanction orders and convey the decisions of the BoG of the institute. The principal of the institute is responsible for all academic and administrative activities and day-to-day functioning of the institute. 3.	The procedure followed in the decision-making process, including channels of supervision and accountability	Refer Chapter 9 The Institute of Hotel Management, Catering & Nutrition, Pusa, New Delhi (IHM Pusa) is an autonomous body of the Government of India under the administrative and financial control of the Ministry of Tourism. It is governed by the Board of Governors (BoG) consisting of senior officers of the Government of India, nominated officers of NCHMCT and Government of NCT of Delhi, and eminent persons of the hospitality sector of the country who are the experts of hotel and catering industry. The Secretary (Tourism) of the Government of India is the chairperson of the board and the Principal of the institute is the Member Secretary of the board. The decision-making process and channels of supervision and accountability are regulated by the Board of Governors (BoG) of the institute. The institute follows the rules and regulations of the Government of India such as CCS Rules, Fundamental Rules and Supplementary Rules (FRs & SRs), General Financial Rules 2017 as amended from time to time (GFRs) and other rules framed by the Government of India, under the directions of Board of Governors and the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India. The institute comes under the jurisdiction of the Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT, New Delhi).
